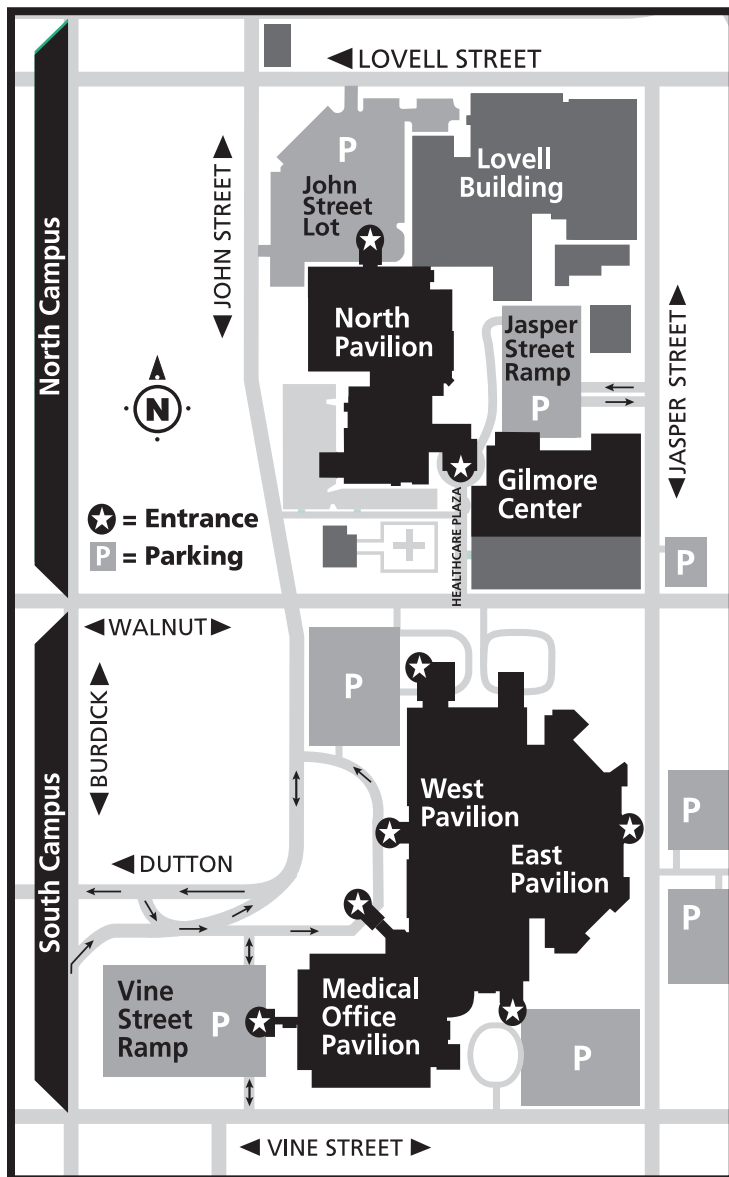


Bronson BirthPlace – Kalamazoo

Where to Go When It's Time to Have Your Baby



Where To Go

Take Healthcare Plaza to Bronson's South Entrance on the North Campus (see map). This entrance is staffed 24 hours a day. Come directly to the Labor & Delivery Unit in the Bronson BirthPlace on the fourth floor.

Parking

Parking is available in the Jasper Street Parking Ramp. There is also a drop-off area at the South Entrance.

Visitors

Mom's support person(s) is welcome on the unit for unlimited visitation. Visiting guidelines for people other than mom's support person(s) are 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. These guidelines have been established to support mom and baby's need for rest and recovery.

Labor & Delivery: All visitors to the Labor & Delivery Unit on the fourth floor can check in with the greeter between 6 a.m. and 2 a.m. Between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. please use the phone located near the entrance. You will need the first and last name of the mother to gain entrance.

Mother/Baby Unit: After the birth, mom and baby will be on the Mother/Baby Unit on the fifth floor. All visitors to the Mother/Baby Unit can check in with the greeter between 10 a.m. and 8 p.m. Between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m. please use the phone located near the entrance. You will need the first and last name of the mother to gain entrance.

Your Safety

The Bronson BirthPlace is a secured access unit. That means that visitors must get permission to enter. Securing access to the unit:

- **Improves security** to continue Bronson's perfect safety record of zero infant abductions.
- **Supports patient confidentiality** by making sure appropriate visitors are on the unit.
- **Improves patient satisfaction** by providing a more restful stay for moms and babies by helping them manage visitors.
