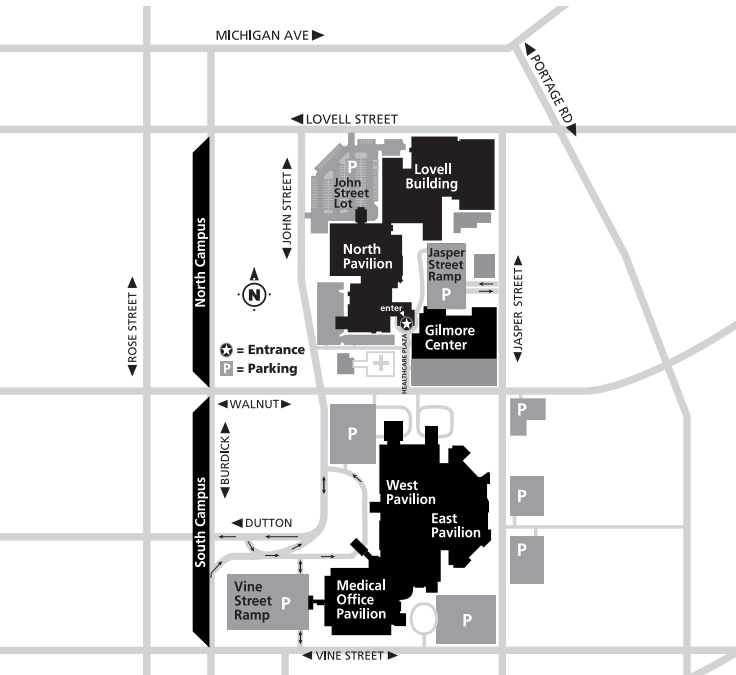


## Where to Arrive

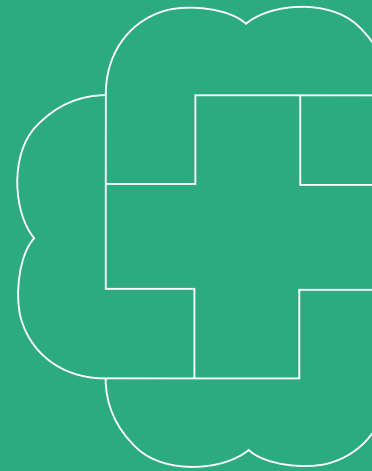
