



### **DAISY Team Award**

Criteria for a nurse-led TEAM nomination:

*The DAISY Team Award honors the collaboration between two or more care team members, led by a nurse. Together, the team was able to meet patient and family needs by going above and beyond the traditional role of nursing.*

*The DAISY Team Award is awarded to a nurse-led team once a year.*

- Nomination is for a care team, led by a nurse
  - Care team can include doctors, physician assistants, nurses, PCA's, clinical care coordinators and/or any other hospital discipline.
- Nomination can be made by any patient, family member or Bronson staff member
- Several members of the nominated team has formed a special connection with the patient and/or family
- The whole nominated team:
  - includes patient (and patient's family, if applicable) in the planning of care
  - does an excellent job educating patient (and patient's family, if applicable)
  - works together well to meet patient's needs
  - makes patient (and patient's family, if applicable) feel comfortable
  - goes above and beyond to provide the best possible experience for patient

**Some examples of extraordinary collaborations that may be honored with The DAISY Team Award include:**

- A "Prom" organized for a patient who is unable to go to her/his own school dance.
- An emergency department team dealing with multiple accident victims.
- A wedding for a patient who is unable to attend her/his own outside of the healthcare facility.
- A fund to provide haircuts to patients who will lose their hair during treatment. Then donating the hair to a charitable organization that can put the hair to good use.
- A process for creating mementos of patients to be given to family members.
