



CT Exam Patient Scheduling Instructions

Questions to Ask Patients

What is the patient's height (in inches)?	Does the patient have Multiple Myeloma? - If yes, Is the Multiple Myeloma: Active or in Remission?
What is the patient's weight (in pounds)?	Does the patient have a power port (s)he wants accessed for this exam?
What is the patient's age (in years)?	Does the patient suffer from dehydration?
Is the patient allergic or sensitive to contrast, dyes, or iodine?	Has the patient had IV contrast in the last 3 to 10 days?
Does the patient have: - Diabetes? - Hypertension? - Immunodeficiency Syndrome? - <i>Tip: Immunodeficiency Syndrome includes AIDS.</i>	In the last 30 days, has the patient had: - Chemotherapy? - Sepsis? - Shock?
Is the patient taking a: - Metformin Medication? - Medication for Hypertension? - Nephrotoxic Medication? - NSAID daily for greater than two weeks?	Has the patient had an organ transplant? - If yes: When did the organ transplant take place? - <i>Tip: Please list full date if available.</i>
Is the patient on Hemodialysis or Peritoneal Dialysis? - If yes, have they been on dialysis for greater than 3 months?	Has the patient had bariatric surgery? - If yes: Date of bariatric surgery?
Does the patient have (or has had): - One functioning Kidney? - Renal Cancer or Surgery? - Renal Insufficiency? - Transplanted Kidney?
