

Bronson Wellness Center COVID-19 Precautions Check-In Process

The safety of our members and staff has always, and will always, be our top priority.

As we address the need for social distancing, masks and extra cleanliness precautions, checking-in at the club looks a bit different these days. These improvements will help keep you, your fellow gym-goers, and our team safe and healthy while we work through the challenges that COVID-19 has brought our way.

What to expect when you arrive at the club

1. In accordance with state mandates, a properly fitted mask is required at all times.
 - According to the state of Michigan, the following items are not sufficient replacements for cloth or surgical-style face masks: scarves, ski masks, balaclavas, neck gaiters, plastic masks, vented face masks and face shields.
 - The only exception to this rule is when you are in the pool – both for lap swim and water exercise classes.
2. When you enter the club, you will see green social distancing markers on the floor. Please stand on the first available marker, and do not advance to the next marker until the person in front of you has moved ahead.
3. Before approaching the desk, please use the hand sanitizer provided.
4. We have installed a Plexiglass guard at the desk – providing a barrier between you and the staff member checking you in.
5. As you swipe your membership card at the service desk, we will ask you two COVID screening questions:
 - Have you had a fever or chills in the past 72 hours?
 - In the past 10 days, have you had a new onset cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing or loss of taste/smell?
6. Lastly, you will look at the facial temperature scanner located next to the gate. Once verified as normal (below 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit), wait for the gate light to turn green and walk through. Enjoy your workout!
