

COVID-19 Vaccinations at Bronson

By Appointment Only

We are following the guidance from the State of Michigan and working with our county health departments and community partners for COVID-19 vaccine distribution. We look forward to vaccinating as many people as possible, and appreciate your patience. Vaccines are by appointment only, and walk-ins are unable to be accepted at this time. Sign Up Through Bronson MyChart

To make an appointment, sign up through your Bronson MyChart account. You will be asked to fill out a questionnaire and choose a location and time that works for you for your first dose. The vaccine is administered in two doses, 21 or 28 days apart. Keep this in mind when you're signing up. It is critical you get both doses. After your first dose is administered, you will receive a prompt on MyChart to schedule your second dose.

Appointments are only available to people in the current or earlier phases, and are based on the amount of vaccine we receive from the federal government. If you qualify for the current phase and there are no appointments available, please check back the following day. For real-time updates, visit bronsonhealth.com/covid19vaccine.

At Your Appointment

Please bring your state issued photo identification card and your health insurance, Medicaid or Medicare card(s). If you are on Medicare, please bring both your Medicare Advantage and Medicare red, white and blue cards. If you do not have health insurance, you can still get the vaccine.

You should also wear clothing that allows access to the upper arm. After you receive your vaccine, you are required to remain onsite for at least 15 minutes.

While at your appointment, you must wear a mask at all times and practice social distancing of at least 6 feet from others.


COVID-19 Vaccine Locations

Calhoun County






